TOPIC: On-line Courses for Firefighter 1 students

PURPOSE: To supplement the resident Firefighter 1 training program

BACKGROUND: Each Firefighter 1 student is required to complete each of the three on-line courses identified below and provide certificates of completion to the Monmouth County Fire Academy 2 weeks prior to the graduation date. *Problems arise when accessing these web sites via AOL, try using Internet Explorer if you encounter problems.*

ON-LINE COURSES:

Each student shall provide a National Fire Academy certificate of completion for:

- Emergency Response to Terrorism (Course Q534)
- ICS-100, Introduction to ICS for Operational First Responders (Course Q462)

Go to <http://www.nfaonline.dhs.gov> and follow the link for New Students. Under the link for new students, you can click on Browse Courses Now to see the 2 courses required. After successful completion, you can print out the certificate of completion that the NFA will send you to your e-mail address; simply follow the directions to get the certificates.

Each student shall provide a FEMA certificate of completion for:

- IS-700 National Incident management System, An Introduction

Go to <http://training.fema.gov/IS/crslist.asp> and click on course IS-700 National Incident Management System (NIMS), An Introduction. After successful completion, you can print out the certificate of completion that FEMA will send you to your e-mail address; simply follow the directions to get the certificate.
